

# RULES AND REGULATIONS PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be judged in accordance therewith.
- Stabling in permanent stalls with doors is available for \$65.00 per horse; \$15 per stall Friday afternoon for jumpers. No shipping-in allowed due to very limited trailer parking.
- 3. The Buffalo Therapeutic Riding Center, its show management, agents, and employees will in no case be responsible for any accident, loss, or damage which may occur to any horse, rider, or equipment before, during, or after the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Buffalo Therapeutic Riding Center, their show management, agents, and employees harmless for any illness, loss, or accident which may occur.
- Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule Book, it shall be referred to the show committee and manager whose decision shall be final.
- All fees must be paid, or covered by an "open" signed check and entry completed before numbers can be issued. <u>Please fill out all sections of the</u> entry blank.
- The committee and manager reserve the right to cancel or combine any classes as deemed necessary.
- 7. The management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry, or to return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to Judges or Officials on the part of the owner, rider, trainer, or groom shall disqualify the entry and the owner shall forfeit entry and other fees. Management may measure any pony in question.
- All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
- Dogs must be leashed <u>at all times</u> while on the grounds. No dogs are to be left in vehicles. We encourage you not to bring your dogs.
- It is a condition of entry that these rules and regulations be read, understood, and accepted.
- 11. Prize Money will be paid in the show office by credit to the horse's account.
- 12. Eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted.
- 13. All accounts must be settled in full at the show. There will be a \$25.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank and a \$25.00 billing fee for all accounts not paid in full at the show. ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN US FUNDS.
- 14. Every rider entered will be charged a \$15.00 EMT/Schooling Fee.
- A \$100.00 non-show fee will be charged to every horse on the grounds that is not showing.

#### **NEW YORK EQUESTRIAN HELMET STATUTE**

New York is the first state in the United States to enact a statute requiring the wearing of an approved equestrian helmet while riding a horse. The bill was signed into law on September 7, 1999 and became effective January 5, 2000.

#### Vehicle and Traffic Law Wearing of Helmets

- 1. No person less than fourteen years of age shall ride a horse unless such a person is wearing a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTMF 1163 (SAFETY EQUIPMENT INSTITUTE CERTIFIED) Equestrian standard. For purposes of this section, "certified" shall mean that the helmet's manufacturer agrees to the rules and provisions of a system that includes independent testing and quality control audits, and that each helmet manufactured by such manufacturer is permanently marked with the certifying body's registered mark or logo before such helmet is sold or offered for sale. For the purposes of this section, wearing a helmet means having a helmet fastened securely upon the head using the manufacturer's fitting guidelines for the particular model used.
- 2. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall pay a civil fine not to exceed fifty dollars. A police officer shall only issue a summons for violations of this section by a person less than fourteen years of age to the parent or guardian of such person if the violation of such person occurs in the presence of such person's parent or guardian and where such parent or guardian is eighteen years of age or more. Such summons shall only be issued to such parent or guardian, and shall not be issued to the person less than fourteen years of age.
- 3.(A) The court shall waive any civil fine for which a person who violates the provisions of the section would be liable if such person supplies the court with proof that between the date of violations and the appearance date for such violation such person purchased or rented a helmet.
- (B) The court may waive any civil fine for which a person who violates the provisions of the section would be liable if the court finds that due to reasons or economic hardship such person was unable to purchase a helmet.
- 4. The failure of any person to comply with the provisions of this section shall not constitute contributory negligence or assumption of risk, and shall not in any way bar, preclude or foreclose an action for personal injury or wrongful death by or on behalf of such person, not in any way diminish or reduce the damages recoverable in any such action.

#### **General Business Law**

396-DD, Renting of horses; helmets and safety information.

- 1. For the purpose of this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- A. "Horse" includes a horses, pony, mule or hinny.
- B. "Horse Provider" includes any person, firm, corporation or other legal entity hiring or renting out horses for riding or providing training in the riding of horses for consideration.
- 2. Every horse provider shall provide protective helmets to beginning riders and to riders less than fourteen years of age at no cost beyond the rental fee; offer all riders the use of such protective helmets regardless of their age or experience; and provide appropriate helmet safety information to all riders.
- 3. Such helmets shall comply with the requirements of section twelve hundred sixty-five of the vehicle and traffic law.
- 4. A knowing violation of this section shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed fifty dollars for each such violation.

- 4. Eight (8) points will be added for all champions and five (5) points for all reserves for series year end points.
- 5. The following divisions will receive year-end awards, championship ribbons and reserve champion ribbons, if and only if the division fills for three or more shows:
  - Low Children's Hunter, Low Adult Hunter, Non-Pro Hunter, The Gail Valentine Wick Memorial Open Eq. Class, Modified Junior / Amateur, Baby Green Hunter, Pleasure Division, Puddle Jumpers, Training Jumpers, Beginner Rider, Crossrail, Thoroughbred, and Open.
- 6. Any horse coming onto the Buffalo Therapeutic Riding Center grounds <u>MUST</u> follow USEF Rule GR48 in addition to having a current Coggins, proof of strangles, rhino, and EHV-1 vaccination mailed or emailed to our office no later than 1 week prior to the show.
- 7. Due to the volume of entries, please have your entries to the horse show office by 3 pm Friday.
- 8. Championships will be awarded in all hunter sections in accordance with USEF Equestrian Rules. All hunter classes will carry full points toward the championship.

#### **DIRECTIONS**

#### FROM 90 EAST OR WEST:

Take 33 West to 198. Take first Delaware Avenue Exit. At stop sign, turn right, then an immediate left onto Delaware Avenue. Proceed on Delaware Avenue to Great Arrow. Turn left on Great Arrow. Turn left into our back gates.

Championships will be awarded in all hunter sections in accordance with USEF Equestrian Rules. All hunter classes will carry full points toward the championship.
